PLATELET RICH PLASMA

What are platelets? Platelets are a specialized type of blood cell fragment in your own blood which are reservoirs of natural growth factors. Platelets rupture and release their growth factors when they find themselves out of their normal environment (which is in your blood vessels).

Typically, this occurs when an injury occurs to the body and blood vessels are ruptured. This could be due to an accidental cut or scrape or a bruise. The released growth factors then get to work building new blood vessels and new blood vessels and new tissue. In normal circumstances, growth factors are important in healing and skin regeneration.

- Growth factors stimulate collagen secretion, cell growth and tissue remodelling.
- Growth factors stimulate development of new blood vessels to improve skin nourishment.
- Growth factors attract stem cells to assist in this role of new tissue regeneration. By injecting platelets in a PRP, we harness this new tissue regeneration ability of the growth factors.
- PRP assists in recovery from the ageing process and importantly, enhances the results of other rejuvenation treatments.

WHAT WILL I FEEL RIGHT AFTER THE TREATMENT?

The sensations vary between each person and treatment. Since PRP is autologous (ie. It comes from your own blood), adverse reactions are rare. You may experience slight redness, swelling mild bruising and pain. Those reactions usually pass in a day or two.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF CELLENIS PRP?

This treatment can improve skin texture and tone, refine wrinkles, and reduce scars such as acne or stretch marks while preserving the natural appearance. Cellenis PRP can also be used to promote hair growth when injected into the scalp. Visible results may take between I-I2 weeks and vary between individuals, depending on different factors such as general health, age, diet, smoking and skin types.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PRP AND DERMAL FILLERS?

Dermal filler is a synthetic material designed to give volume and fill up lines in a specific area. PRP is self-sourced and actively helps your skin to repair itself by improving skin complexion and restoring its natural glow.

CAN THIS TREATMENT BE COMBINED WITH OTHER TREATMENTS?

Clinical evidence has shown that combining PRP with other rejuvenation techniques, such as fillers, mesotherapy and laser treatments induces a synergistic beneficial effect.

HOW MANY TREATMENTS WILL I NEED?

Initially, your physician will examine your skin and other factors and recommend a treatment regimen. In many cases, Cellenis PRP treatment is performed in a series of three sessions, 3-8 weeks apart. Maintenance treatments are recommended every 6-12 months for optimal long lasting results.

ARE THERE ANY CONTRAINDICATIONS?

Contraindications include pregnancy, breast feeding, autoimmune or blood pathologies and cancer. Furthermore, consistent use of NSAID drugs within 48 hours of Cellenis PRP application should be avoided. For more information, please consult Rippon Medical.
